



## Self-Guided Online Course in Distance Learning

### Overview

Distance learning is a significant shift—for schools, teachers, students, and families. Though most educators had to move online very quickly, we now have a moment to build flexible learning models that respond to student needs and changing conditions. We can go from crisis response to effective practice.

In BetterLesson’s self-guided online course, “Tool, Time, Task: Foundations of Distance Learning”, teachers will explore the fundamental components of effective virtual instruction, learn from mentors and peers, and create an action plan.

### Who is this course for?

This course is for K-12 teachers who want to design an effective distance learning approach, with a focus on student-centered practices, equity, and access. It is fundamental material for teachers who will start school fully online, or in a hybrid model, or even in-person with the need to be “distance-ready.” The course works well alongside other PD supports such as coaching.

### How does it work?

**Modules:** The course is divided into 5 modules:

- **Module 1:** What is distance learning?
- **Module 2 (Tools):** How can we organize a space for distance learning, using the best tools?
- **Module 3 (Time):** How can we create a learning cadence, including synchronous and asynchronous approaches?
- **Module 4 (Task):** How can we design engaging and meaningful learning tasks?
- **Module 5:** What do the foundations of distance learning look like in your context?

**Access:** Available on the Moodle online platform, all self-paced

**Define:** Learn new distance learning concepts

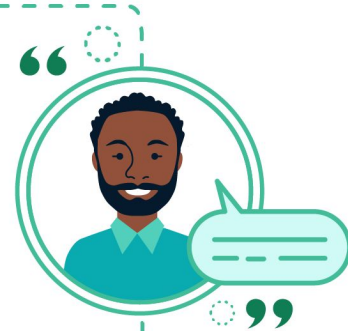
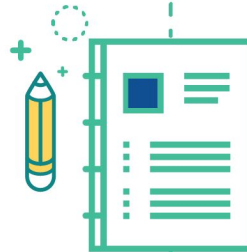
**Explore:** Review a variety of instructional resources

**Build:** Create a piece of your distance learning plan



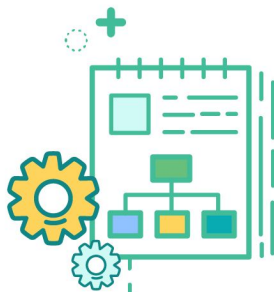
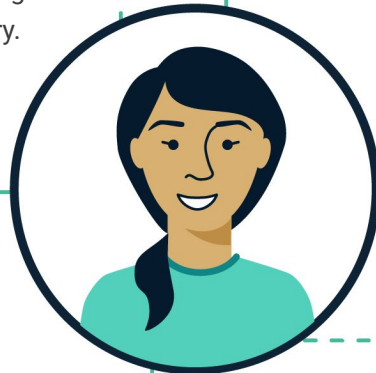
### Instructional Vision First
